

ACCEPTANCE OF RISKS AND RENUNCIATION

The World Health Organization officially declared a COVID-19 pandemic on March 11, 2020. COVID-19 is an infectious disease caused by the most recently discovered coronavirus. The main symptoms of COVID-19 are fever, new or worsening cough, difficulty breathing or sudden loss of smell without a stuffy nose, with or without loss of taste. The symptoms can be mild (similar to a cold) or more severe (such as those associated with pneumonia and respiratory or kidney failure). COVID-19 can cause serious illness requiring hospital treatment and death in certain cases. The Trevor Williams Kids Foundation (the “TWKF”) will offer its summer camp in 2021 (the “2021 Camp”). The TWKF has made several adjustments to its usual activities and has implemented reasonable measures in an effort to comply with the applicable guidelines issued by the Government of Québec to limit the spread of COVID-19, such as those included in the Toolkit for the Day Camp Sector (<https://www.cnesst.gouv.qc.ca/salle-de-presse/covid-19-info-en/Pages/toolkit-day-camp-sector.aspx>). The measures taken by the TWKF include but are not limited to the reduction of the number of participants and counsellors, the instauration of social distancing measures and the provision of hand sanitizer.

Despite the measures taken by the TWKF, there exists an inherent risk that the participants may catch COVID-19 by participating in the activities organized by the TWKF as part of the 2020 Camp. If this risk realizes, such participants may experience all or any of the symptoms of COVID-19, including serious illness or death, and may also spread the COVID-19 to other people with the same consequences. Compliance with the instructions given by the TWKF and/or its counsellors may help reduce the risk of catching COVID-19. However, there exists no means to fully avoid the risk of catching COVID-19 inherent in participating in the activities organized by the TWKF as part of the 2021 Camp.

By registering a participant in the 2020 Camp, you therefore agree on behalf of such participant and yourself (a) that the measures taken by the TWKF to limit the spread of COVID-19 are adequate and reasonable; (b) that you will fully comply with all instructions, measures and procedures given or taken by the TWKF and/or its counsellors to limit the spread of COVID-19; (c) that you have received from the statements and references above, or independently gathered, all the information about the risk inherent in participating in the activities organized by the TWKF as part of the 2021 Camp which is necessary to allow you to make a free and informed choice in this regard; and (d) that you express your wish to fully accept and assume such risk as well as the harm that might ensue, thereby renouncing your rights to sue the TWKF, its counsellors and/or the other participants of the 2021 Camp.
